## VINEYARD

**Terroir:** sandy silt with schists.  
**Grape varieties:** 90% Gamay and 10% Pinot noir.  
**Surface area:** 0.5 hectares.  
**Age of vines:** 20 years.  
**Reasoned agriculture:** mechanical weeding, tillage.



## CLIMATE CONDITIONS

**Winter:** mild.  
**Spring:** a few frosts.  
**Summer:** heat and drought.  
**Autumn:** Indian summer.



## HARVEST DATE

September 12<sup>th</sup>

## WINEMAKING

**Harvest:** mechanical.  
**Pressing:** direct with juice selection.  
**Settling:** cold.  
**Fermentation:** in thermoregulated stainless-steel vats.  
**Aging:** stainless vats.  
**Blend:** 90% Gamay - 10% Pinot Noir



## TASTING



**Appearance:** pale salmon color.  
**Nose:** opening with notes of raspberries and an inciting hint of amyl.  
**Palate:** full of freshness with notes of strawberry and raspberry. A beautiful presence that extends with an elegant freshness.

## WINE PAIRING



To be enjoyed as an aperitif with a few tapas or sushi. It will of course accompany cold cuts and local cheeses. Asian cuisine is well suited for this decadent wine to delight you with its freshness.
